

# A word from the president



#### Fonds Jean-Carignan

The GMMQ established the Fonds Jean-Carignan in 2011 with the objective of supporting professional musicians in need. Named after Jean Carignan, the famed Québec violinist who died in poverty in 1988, this fund provides assistance, where required, to musicians in financial and social difficulty. The Fonds Jean-Carignan is one of seven funds associated with the Union des Artistes' Fondation des artistes (FDA). This partnership allows us, specifically, to issue charitable tax receipts to donors.





Our association with the FDA was improved this year: We're currently working with all FDA affiliates to stage a first major benefit event, the **Défi Impro FDA**, organized by the FDA. The event will incude an improvisation match presented by the Caisse de la Culture Desjardins, featuring a pair of teams made up of business community leaders going head to head under the direction of an eminent professional player-improviser and an honourary trainer.

This benefit event will be held at Montreal's Club Soda Tuesday, May 1, 2018 as of 5:30 p.m. (event details). A word of thanks goes out to director Jean-Luc Gagnon and our communications coordinator Isabelle Brien for their invaluable help in organizing this major fundraiser.

As is the case each year, the FJC will organize a "Coups de chapeau" (Hats off) in conjunction with orchestra concerts presented in the year ahead. We're in the process of finalizing the calendar.

This timely assistance is provided in the form of a donation or a loan, and applications are handled with the strictest confidentialty by a committee whose composition is known only by the fund's board of directors.

#### The Coalition la Culture, le cœur du Québec Stages a Demonstration

The Coalition Ia Culture, le cœur du Québec held a demonstration in front of the Parliament building on February 1 the leadup to the next federal budget and the announcement of Québec's cultural policy, the demonstration was i remind MNAs of the importance of providing adequate funding for the arts and adopting an action plan in favour resources for the arts and culture. Among the demonstrators was Johanne Truchon, proud representative of the Québec City.



In order to promote the artistic and cultural sector and ensure its recognition, the **Coalition la culture**, **Ie Québec** advocates in favour of concerted actions based on government policies enacted by authorities in culture, en and education with the goal of **supporting human resources in the arts and culture**.
